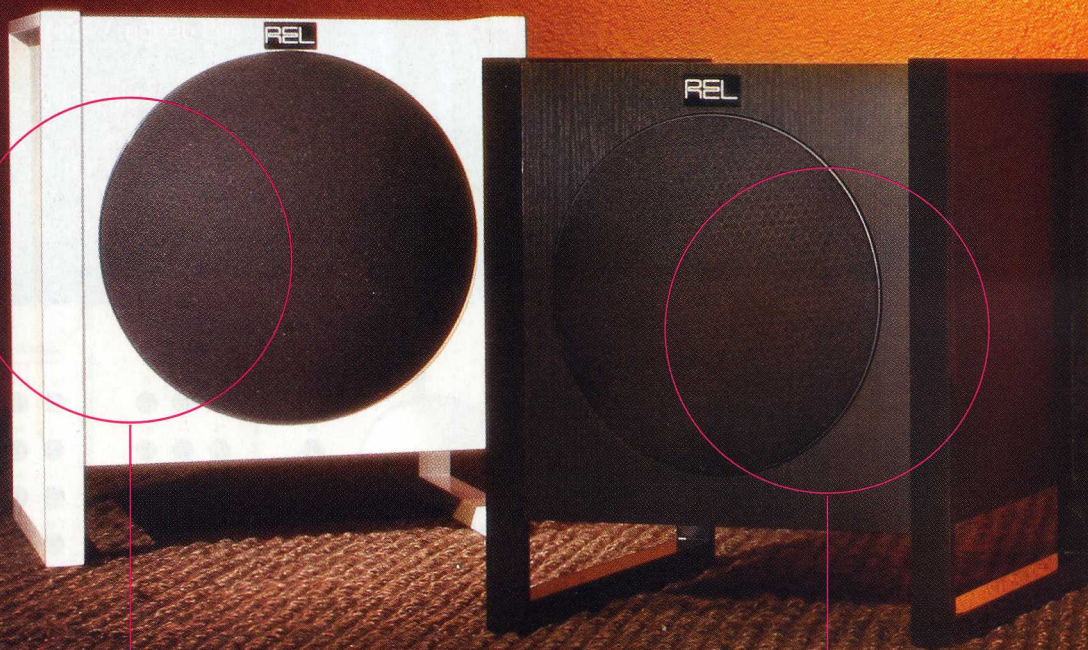


T It Up



REL has long been committed to perfecting their niche, the subwoofer. The company's newest release, the T-Series, stays true to REL's goal of pursuing the apex of deep bass reproduction. These attractively styled subs, the T1, T2, and T3 provide the same quality as REL's previous offerings at more consumer-friendly prices. The T1 houses a 10-inch woofer and rings in at \$995, while the T2 and T3 each have an 8-inch woofer and come in at \$795 and \$595, respectively. The T1 has the largest dimensions (15.75 by 14.2 by 16.5 inches) and comes standard with a 300-watt high-current Class AB amplifier, while the T2 and T3 are equipped with 200-watt and 150-watt Class AB amplifiers. Each T-Series model has a variable crossover of 30 to 120 hertz, a Neutrik Speakon high-level input, and over-current, over-temperature, and under-voltage protection. Each is available in a black-ash-gloss, white, or cherry finish. If you're thinking about committing to perfect bass, then you might as well start with a company that has perfected it to an art form.
